To be entirely effective in spraying apples, this spray must go on just as soon as the petals fall, as the calyx cups close very quickly and it is impossible to place the poison in these if the spraying is delayed.

This spray is used primarily for the control of codling moth for which purpose arsenate of lead is used. Lime sulphur in the case of apples is recommended also for the control of scab and mildew. Pears should receive the atomic sulphur 12 pounds to 100 gallons of water in the place of lime sulphur. Our observations lead us to believe that it is not wise to apply lime sulphur in the calyx spray unless it has been used in one of the earlier applications.


