AGAIN THE MOTH

(By Logan Clarke)

At the present time it is believed that the worst moth will be the most serious pest in the Hood River district this year as it was during the past season. All growers in the valley should therefore take precaution to reduce the damage caused by this pest to the minimum.

In the first place, probably much of our trouble results from the fact that growers do not use enough material to thoroughly spray their trees. It is much better to waste a little material than to endeavor to save it.

1st: The tops of the trees are usually the parts most often missed by the gun-man. When working from the ground the operator is always looking through a fog of spray and is often misled in believing that the spray that he sees is being deposited on the higher foliage.

2d: In the case of older orchards and very high trees, it would be advisable to use one gun from the tops of the rig in order to insure thorough coating of this part of the tree.

3d: The use of sprayers, particularly calcium caseinate, has not been entirely demonstrated as yet but further trials are advocated by the station.

4th: Apply the calyx spray early enough so that the poison may be placed in the apples before the calyx cups are closed.

5th: Recommendations for further cover sprays should be given careful attention by all growers. These recommendations will be issued by the station as they fall due.
