Mr. Gray. The average holding, according to the statement, is 68 shares
of a par value of \$100 each. No one
person, firm, corporation or institution

of a par value of \$100 each. No one person, firm, corporation or institution owns as much as two per cent of the capital stock, the statement adds. Stockholders reside in every state in the Union and in Alaska, Canal Zone, Guam, Hawaii and Philippine Islands. "Thus," says Mr. Gray, "Union Pacific stock, like a country's trade, follows the Flag. This widespread distribution conclusively answers the statement that the railroads are owned and controlled by a few persons. To an extent not generally recognized, the railways are owned by the public. This subject comes home to every household when it is considered that life insurance policy holders and savings, bank depositors are partners in the operation and development of our railways."




