CITY IS FACING A WATER SHORTAGE

While no colon bacilli was discovered, samples of water from the Hakel spring, in the Oak Grove district, one of the sources of supply for the municipal water system, sent to the laboratory of the State Board of Health showed such high bacterial count that the city deemed it wise to cut off the spring, and the city is facing a shortage of water for irrigating lawns and gardens. The pollution, it was declared, resulted from breaks in the ditch of the Farmers' Irrigating Co., which overflowed the spring.

Citizens lately have complained to the water department of an offensive odor to the city water when heated. This, it was explained, resulted from the deposit in one of the reservoirs of a chemical to kill a heavy growth of moss.


