Seed of fine bent grass, resistant to sour, wet conditions, and highly prized for lawns, golf courses, football fields, and other places where turf is needed, are now available. It is being produced in commercial quantities at Coquille, Or., and imports for the current year are moderately heavy.

The remarkable turfs formed by these grasses are probably best for moderately heavy soils. They grow native in many parts of the coast and Willamette vailey sections.

In some instances chopped up sods are scattered over the ground and worked in, the lawns being formed by vegetative development.
