storage must be kept well ventilated to prevent sprouting, which the warmer weather is beginning to cause in many parts of the state, the experiment station has learned. If the potato piles are opened and the potatoes spread out, and the storage places are opened on cold nights and kept closed during the warmer period, the potatoes can be held in good seed condition for a longer period.

The rowy apple aphids are hatching and feeding on the leaves, according to observations by the O. A. C. entomology department. Nicotine sulfate spray is the standard remedy for this pest. It is usually applied between the delayed dormant and pink stages. The experiment station is conducting a series of tests to determine the best time to apply sprays for these aphids. An oil spray has already been applied to destroy the eggs of the insects.
