In Hood River auto camp, the visitor is not offered a mere space of bare ground on which to pitch a tent. He has available numerous screens, a community kitchen, hot and cold showers and the rest of a large community house.

It was originally the intention of the Hood River government to operate the auto park, but early last winter this policy was changed and the park was leased to C. O. Huelat, formerly a member of the city council, who had spent last summer in the development of the institution.

Hundreds of motor tourists the past several years have passed through the city without ever a glimpse of the internationally known orchards. The Columbia River Highway at no point offers a view of the fruit tracts, and at no point along the canyon of the mid-Columbia does the visitor have an opportunity, as he spins along the great, nationally known highway, of viewing the movie spire of Mount Hood.

W. E. Paulhamus, president of the Puyallup and Sumner Fruit Growers Association of Puyallup, a position which he has held continuously since he helped organize it five years ago, passed away last week at his home near Sumner, Wash., after an illness of many months.
