experiments have proved. Investigations by the Department of Agriculture show it is best to put the apples in cold storage immediately after they are picked, and that a great deal of spollage results from shipping when the fruit has not been precooled.

"For several years there has been a movement to encourage building cold storages in the fruit districts, but the taxation feature discourages building."
