MINING EXPECTING LARGE TOMATO CROP

The Hood River tomato crop is expected to be a bumper crop this year, according to Marvin Mosher, who has 7,000 plants on just east of the Washington bridge to the immediate bridge here last week. Mr. Mosher says prospects for a fine crop of tomatoes was never better. The vines are already loaded with green fruit as big as walnuts, and growers expect to be shipping their product to Portland after July 4.

In former years the bulk of the Hood River tomato crop has been marketed in Portland. Growers expect to dispose of the most of the yield of this season there. The tomatoes will be brought across the interstate bridge and moved to the metropolis by motor truck.
