Two Die in Motor Accident

Eva Dann, 21, and James Kirby, 25, both of The Dalles, were killed in a motorcycle wreck on the Columbia highway six miles west of The Dalles Saturday night. Miss Dann died at a hospital at midnight after a futile battle by physicians to save her life. Kirby died at 7 o'clock Sunday morning. His skull was fractured, leaving portions of the brain exposed.

Miss Dann, who was a student in The Dalles high school, Kirby and James Beck were riding on the motorcycle, which had a sidecar attachment. The machine was thought to have skidded on wet pavement.

Kirby was piloting the motorcycle at the time. It was virtually demolished. Beck and Miss Dann were to have been married soon. It was understood. Five persons have lost their lives in traffic accidents during the last two years, on the stretch where the motorcycle crashed.
