FIRST NATIONAL HAS A GIFFORD PHOTO

Here Friday to hang one of his pictures of a Columbia river sunset, taken from a point near Maryhill, Wash. B. A. Gifford, a pioneer photographer of the Pacific northwest, told an interesting story of how he secured the picture in 1923. Maryhill was then known as Columbia.

One twilight, Mr. Gifford was attracted by the beauty of the sunset. The sky was lit with a halo from the setting sun, or "Waukonga," as the Indians called it. Mr. Gifford has called his picture, "Waukonga."

"I had been in the district for some time, seeking proper cloud and landscape blending effects," said Mr. Gifford. "When I saw that richly colored clouded sky, I took my camera down to the river where two Indian tepees stood, a bateau drawn up on the beach in front of them. Two redmen were there, but they declined the \$5 I offered them to pose for me. I have found that from 50 cents to \$5 will buy off the superstition of an Indian now-a-days. You can get any of them for \$5. Not so, however, in those days."

The two redmen, as I saw up my camera, hid behind one of the tepees. After I had focused my camera, I turned aside for my plates. Suddenly a rock plumped down beside me. It caused me to do some guessing. I busied myself again with the focusing, all the while doing some thinking. Again I turned my head and this time a rock as big as my double fist, almost grazed my head. I looked around quickly and saw an Indian hand disappearing behind the tepee, which hid the two bucks.

"I rushed the Indians, and it stampered them. They hastened away and disappeared in one of the tepees, closing the flap. I was able to finish taking the picture in peace."

The picture, in natural colors, has been placed in the main lobby of the First National Bank building.

Mr. Gifford took one of the first pictures to carry the name of Hood over the world. The famous Gifford Mount Hood has been sold by the thousands all over the world.

J. S. CRUTCHFIELD VISITS THE VALLEY

J. S. Crutchfield, of Pittsburgh, president of the American Fruitgrowers, Inc., national marketing concern, here last week visiting the local branch, while expressing an optimism over the general outlook for applegrowers declared the market outlook for the close of the apple deal this year is dark.

Mr. Crutchfield declared that the apple market of the Pacific northwest was too bullish early in the season last year. Dealers in many instances, speculating on fruit, purchased heavily, and storage stocks are now in excess of normal years.

"Many things," said Mr. Crutchfield, "will have an influence on the closing days of the apple market. Freezes and cold rains, destructive to the Pacific coast's early fruit crops, such as California cherries, will tend to lengthen the clean-up period on apples and will enable buyers in a measure to recover."

Mr. Crutchfield was accompanied here by I. H. Oederwall, local manager of the American Fruitgrowers, who has been in charge of the local apple deal. Mr. Oederwall stated that he and Gordon Green will soon return here and remain permanently.

Civil Service Examination

The United States Civil Service Commission announces a Post Office Clerk-Carrier examination for the purpose of establishing an eligible register from which selections may be made to fill vacancies as they may occur in the position of Clerk-Carrier, Post Office Service, at Hood River, Oregon. Salary is \$1700 per annum (for first year at full time); substitute service is paid at the rate of 65 cents per hour. Applications will be received by the Secretary, Eleventh U. S. Civil Service District, Seattle, Washington, up to 9 a. m., May 6, 1926. The date of examination will be shown on the admission cards furnished applicants.

All citizens of the United States who meet the requirements, both men and women, may enter this examination; appointing officers, however, have the legal right to specify the sex desired in requesting certification of eligibles. Age limits, 18 to 45 years on the date of examination. Age limits do not apply to persons entitled to preference on account of military or naval service.
