FLORIDA CALLED U. S. CHIN WHISKER

Recently the Glacier carried a brief sketch of California. That sketch included the following on Florida:

Florida is the chin whisker of the United States. It is six hundred miles long, two hundred miles wide, and three feet high. It is bounded on the north by the eighteenth amendment and on the other three sides by the three mile limit.

LINN COUNTY—Indian Prairie lake. **MARION COUNTY**—Jude lake, Brook lake, Heed lake, First lake, Clifford lake, Middle lake, Finley lake, Triangle lake, Sligh lake, Sheep lake, Wall lake, Averil lake.

WALLOWA COUNTY—Wood lake, Frances lake, Swamp lake, Hobo lake, Lilly lake, Maxwell lake. **WASCO COUNTY**—Frog lake and Boulder lake.

Notice is hereby given that by an order duly and regularly made by the State Game Commission of the State of Oregon on the 11th day of January, 1926, it was found and determined that the supply of trout and fish of all kinds is being, and will be, injuriously affected by permitting the same to be taken during the periods of time hereinafter specified from the streams, lakes and waters hereinafter named, and that during the period of time beginning on the 15th day of April, 1926, and ending on the 15th day of April, 1927, both dates inclusive, it shall be unlawful for any person to kill, angle for, take or have in possession, any species of trout or other fish of any kind or species from the following described streams, lakes and waters of the State of Oregon, to-wit:

All that part of the Willamette river, beginning at a point on Black Point at the west corner of the Hawley Paper and Pulp Company's Electric Station, situated on the east bank of said Willamette river, in Clackamas County, Oregon, thence running in a westerly direction across said Willamette River to a point on the Island in line with the east corner of the Crown Willamette Paper Company's Pulp mill situated on the west side of said river; thence in a southerly direction to the deadline established by an act of the State Legislature, 200 feet below the line across said river to the east bank of said river; thence following said deadline across said river to the east bank of said river; thence in a northerly direction to the place of beginning at the west corner of the Hawley Pulp & Paper Company's Electric Station located on Black Point.

CONSTRUCTION ON YAKIMA ROAD STARTS

Actual construction on the Mt. Adams highway along the line of permanent location began April 1, according to word received from Yakima. The United States labor office has been instructed to sign up men for the job. It is reported that 400 men will be sent to work as soon as crews get lined up along the right of way.

The work will be done under direction of the Indian forestry service, with Harry Lynch, district forester, in charge. Funds from the forestry service, supplemented by contributions made by residents of White Swan amounting to approximately \$6,000, will be used for the improvement of the worst sections along the divide between Tappanish creek and Signal Peak ranger station. Four miles of new road will be built along the line of the permanent survey.

With this announcement comes the additional information that residents of Glenwood and White Salmon are putting crews at work on the road between Glenwood and the crossing of the Klitchita, indicating that this scenic route from Portland to Yakima will be opened for travel by midsummer in a greatly improved condition.

Notice of Game Fish Stream and Lake Closing

Notice is hereby given that by an order duly and regularly made by the State Game Commission of the State of Oregon on the 11th day of January, 1926, it was found and determined that the supply of trout and fish of all kinds is being, and will be, injuriously affected by permitting the same to be taken during the periods of time hereinafter specified from the streams, lakes and waters hereinafter named, and that during the period of time beginning on the 15th day of April, 1926, and ending on the 15th day of April, 1926, both dates inclusive, it shall be unlawful for any person to kill, angle for, take or have in possession, except as hereinafter specified, any species of trout or other fish of any kind or species from the following described streams, lakes and waters of the State of Oregon, to-wit:

BAKER COUNTY—Crawfish lake, Rock Creek lake, Black lake, Anthony lake, Grande Ronde lake, Mud lake, and Van Pattin lake, closed from October 1 to June 15 of each year. Goose creek, Balm creek, Big creek, Wolfe creek, Deer creek, McCully creek, Elk creek, and Anthony creek, tributaries of Powder river, closed from August 15 to April 15 of each year, both dates inclusive.

DESCHUTES COUNTY—Elk lake, East lake, Twin lakes, Lava lake, Little Lava lake, Three Creek lake and Paulina lake, closed from September 10 to April 15 of each year, both dates inclusive.

GRANT COUNTY—Strawberry lake, Magoon lake, Olive lake, Lake Creek reservoir and Lake creek, closed from April 15 to June 15 of each year, both dates inclusive.

HOOD RIVER COUNTY—East Fork of Hood river above its junction with the West Fork of Hood river; Middle Fork of Hood river above its junction with the East Fork of Hood river; West Fork of Hood river above its junction with the East Fork of Hood river, together with all tributaries thereof, closed from November 30 to June 1 of each year, both dates inclusive. Lost Lake Branch creek closed from November 30 to June 1 of each year, both dates inclusive.

KLAMATH COUNTY—Seven Mile creek, closed from November 30 to June 1 of each year. Wood river and tributaries closed to June 15 of each year. Klamath river for a distance of 4,000 feet below and 2,000 feet above the mouth of Spencer creek, closed to June 15 of each year.

LAKE COUNTY—Campbell lake and Dead Horse lake closed from September 1 to July 15 of each year, both dates inclusive.

POLE COUNTY—The South Fork of the Siletta river from the dam owned by the Cobb & Mitchell Lumber company, including the mill pond above said dam, and Handy creek, Sand creek and Beaver creek, closed from July 15 to April 15 of each year, both dates inclusive.

UNION COUNTY—Latit creek closed from November 30 to July 15 of each year, both dates inclusive.

WALLOWA COUNTY—Wallowa lake and tributary streams closed to taking of "Yanks" Land-Locked Salmon or Redfish with yankhook and jerkhook. These fish to be taken with hook and line, commonly called angling, only. Anoreld lake closed from September 15 to April 15 of each year, both dates inclusive.

And that said streams, lakes and waters be, and are closed, to fishing with hook and line, commonly known as angling, for and during the periods of time above specified.
