### ORIENT OFFERS EXPORT OPPORTUNITY

C. J. Kelly, vice president and general manager of Gets Bros. & Co., a pioneer firm of San Francisco, was here Sunday, returning from a tour of northwestern apple sections. Mr. Kelly said that the apple business in the Orient has received more attention the past year than in former seasons, and as a result the volume of sales increased about 250 per cent over any former year. He declared it his opinion that the Oriental export of boxed apples will be increased very much in the next few years.

Mr. Kelly, who had seen the tracts of Wenatchee and Yakima, said the "set" of apples here seemed as heavy to him as in the Washington commercial centers.

The visitor was shown over the valley by I. H. Cederwall. His firm handles the Blue Goose brand of fruits in the Oriental trade.
