Wasco Fears Cherry Fly A meeting of Wasco county cherry growers to set in motion some plan to protect that district from an infesta tion of the cherry fly was held at the cooperative growers' building Saturday afternoon, under the direction of Coun-

afternoon, under the direction of County Fruit Inspector C. L. Hazen, says The Dalles Chronicle.

Cherries are being shipped in from infested districts, making a spread of the dread disease a possibility, Hazen declared. Numerous channels are open through which precautionary measures may be applied, he declared. Wasco county with an estimated crop of 1800 tons of cherries next year is one of six in the state not under out-of-state quaranthe regulations, because of having a clean and non-infested pack.

Growers are making a concerted campaign now to prepare against the possibility of red spider infestation again next year. At least eight large modern sprayers have been rold in the district this fall.
