CHERRY HARVEST TO START ABOUT JULY

Harvest of the cherry crop here will begin about July 1. The tonnage this season will be a little less than 50 per cent of last year, when 22 cars were shipped. The Apple Growers Association is figuring on 10 cars this year.

The quality of the crop this year is fine. The fruit was thinned by the cold weather prevailing at blossomtime and the cherries will be of extraordinary size. High prices are expected Numerous inquiries are already being received from the cast and middle west where the fruit is marketed in 16 pound boxes.

QUARANTINE ORDER NO. 4

Oregon except as hereinafter provided.

1. Fresh cherries shall not be carried or transported from said infested territory at any time into the counties of Hood River, Wasco, and Umatille unless accompanied by a certificat signed by an inspector of the Orego State Board of Horticulture, certifying that all of the cherries in said shiftment were grown in and packed at ment were grown in and packed a shipped from a section free from cherry fruit fly.

2. Lug boxes and other boxes that have contained fresh cherries shall not be carried or transported into the counties of Hood River, Wasco or Umatilia from said infested territory except that such shipments be accompanied by a certificate signed by an inspector of the Oregon State Board of Horticulture stating that all of the boxes in said shipment were dipped in boiling water or subjected to live steam in a closed container for a period of two minutes, and that said boxes are free from all fruit, leaves and twigs of the cherry.

3. Nothing in this order shall be construed to prohibit the transportation of fresh cherries or lug boxes or other countainers of fresh cherries intracounty in the quarantined area, or into such other counties of the state of Oregon not mentioned in this order, or through the counties of Hood River, wasco and Umatilla.






