PATHOLOGIST TO STUDY APPLE CANKER

Dr. Jacquelin S. Cooley, assistant pathologist, has been designated by Director Taylor of the bureau of plant industry of the department of agriculture to come to Oregon shortly to aid state officials in their fight on the apple canker, now troubling orchardists in the Hood River valley.

He will maintain close contact with D. F., Fisher, in charge of the federal fruit disease laboratory at Wenatchee, Wash., and with Leroy Childs, superintendent of the state substation at Hood River. His program also calls for co-

While no negotiations have been entered into between the city and Judge Derby, the council has appointed a committee to investigate a municipal power system, utilizing the up-river power site.


