### PATHOLOGIST TO STUDY APPLE CANKER

Dr. Jacquelin S. Cooley, assistant pathologist, has been designated by Director Taylor of the bureau of plant industry of the department of agriculture to come to Oregon shortly to aid state officials in their fight on the apple canker, now troubling orchardists in the Hood River valley.  
He will maintain close contact with D. F. Fisher, in charge of the federal fruit disease laboratory at Wenatchee, Wash., and with Leroy Childs, superintendent of the state station at Hood River. His program also calls for cooperation with the state experimental station at Corvallis, where Dr. James T. Jardine is keenly interested in the fight on the canker.

Both Senator McNary and Senator Stetler of Oregon have been active in efforts to obtain federal aid in the campaign to exterminate the canker, but the agricultural department has been unable to help them because of lack of funds. Dr. Cooley is expected to reach Oregon about January 1, by which date the deficiency bill, carrying emergency appropriations for all departments, is expected to have passed congress.  
Representative N. J. Sinnott was also active in securing the pathologist.

### JUDGE DERBY FILES ON THE WEST FORK

Judge A. J. Derby, who several weeks ago contracted with the Oregon Lumber Co. for water rights on the East Fork of Hood River, announced Monday that he had filed on 125 second feet of water on the West Fork. The power project which he plans to develop would include a powerhouse near the confluence of the two streams. The flow of the two streams under his control will develop 2,000 constant horsepower. It was stated.  
While no negotiations have been entered into between the city and Judge Derby, the council has appointed a committee to investigate a municipal power system, utilizing the up-river power site.

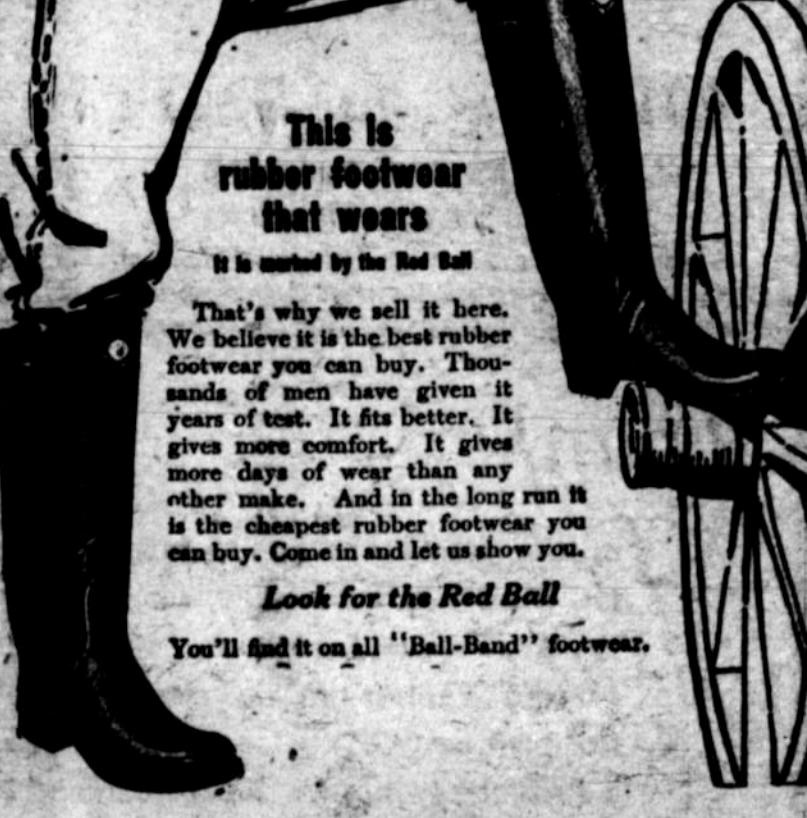
