### EARLY SPRING FRESHET HOLDING UP SALMON RUN.

Chinook salmon are commencing to move upstream, above the rapids, after having been held in the lower river by the high water. Fishermen who hustled off to Celilo and other points in the vicinity of The Dalles have been having no luck, but the boats working in the vicinity of Bradford island have been reasonably well.

Old timers say the run is the earliest since 1894, and claim that it is unusually heavy. For days the salmon have been laying in deep holes, in the vicinity of Bonneville. This is said to explain the heavy catches which anglers have been making at the mouth of Tanner creek.

Indians at Celilo have not been taking any quantity of fish, but are hopeful that their luck will change as the river falls. However, the old timers are not so certain that the fishing will be so good on the upper river, for the reason, they say, that the salmon will be able to pass the falls at Celilo in the high water with greater ease than in ordinary years.

### SCHOOL BOARD AGREES TO REEMPLOY NASSHAHN

The county school board, acting upon a petition filed by the people of Cascade Locks, are preparing to renew the contract of W. A. Nasshahn principal of the grade school.

A deligation from the Parent-Teachers association waited upon the board late last week and presented the petition, which had been by practically all of the parents of pupils in the grade school.

Contracts of the other teachers in the grade and high school were renewed last month for a year. For some reason the board held up Mr. Nasshahn's contract. The explanation was offered by one board member that action was purposely delayed for the reason that he and other board members desired to hear an expression from the people of Cascade Locks. Well, they heard, and now everybody appears to be happy and satisfied.

### BONNEVILLE CHURCH TO GET SUPPLY PASTOR

As a result of efforts of a group of Bonneville people, the Portland Council of Churches has agreed to supply a minister every week for Sunday morning church services at the Community House in Bonneville.

Samuel Lancaster, who built the Columbia River highway, and now lives on the hill overlooking the dam site, is superintendent of the Sunday school, and chairman of the board which has charge of the church services. He has expressed the hope and wish that church goers of Cascade Locks will drive to Bonneville for the Sunday morning services instead of attempting to obtain a supply pastor for their Methodist Community church. The Community House at Bonneville has a seating capacity of 100 people.
