LANCASTER SAYS LOCKS SHOULD BE CHANGED TO LAKE

Speaking Monday before the noon-day forum of the Portland chamber of commerce, Samuel C. Lancaster proposed that the name of Cascade Locks be changed to Cascade Lake. The change, he declared, would go far toward attracting attention to the fact that with completion of Bonneville dam Cascade Locks will nestle at the edge of one of the largest lakes in the west.

Mr. Lancaster proposed afterwards that stakes be set at once to show the height to which water will rise when the mammoth reservoir behind the dam becomes a reality.

In his talk he explained that Cascade Locks is above the high water line and told the Portland people of the opportunity here for a summer playground.

Cascade Locks soon to be a thing of the past for changes have come, said Mr. Lancaster.

The Bonneville Dam and Locks will bring new life and charm to this region, beyond the power of many to imagine. The Town Site will not be effected. By way of comparison, come with me to Lake Lucern, the most beautiful spot in Switzerland. Let us drive along the world famous Axenstrasse and enjoy the marvelous beauty of the lake, as we look out through three windows cut out of the solid rock. Lake Lucern is 23 miles in length from the city of Lucern to Fluelen, and the total arc of the lake is 43 square miles.

The building of the Bonneville Dam is creating a lake 46 miles in length, between Bonneville and Big Eddy, three miles east of The Dalles. The arc of Lake surface between these points will be more than twice as great as Lake Lucern.

The scenery in the Gorge of the Columbia between these points is more beautiful and the variety far greater than Lake Lucern. With these facts before you ladies and gentlemen, permit me to suggest a change of name from Cascade Locks to Cas-

cade Lake in the heart of the Columbia Gorgeous.

Bids will be opened June 1 for re-locating the main line of the S. P. & S. railroad tracks on the Washington side of the Columbia, from a point a mile west of North Bonneville to Fort Rains, a mile below the toll bridge.

The work will provide employment of 200 men for the next 12 months and will cost an estimated \$500,000. Workmen employed on the job will be quartered in North Bonneville in bunk houses to be built by the contractor.
