

STATE TO BUILD SUPER HIGHWAY THROUGH GORGE

Aid to Be Sought From Govern. ment for Water Level Road From the Locks to Portland.

Plans for a fast water level highway through the Columbia Gorge from Cascade Locks to Portland became public Tuesday for the first time when details of a survey which has been completed as far as Dodson were announced at a meeting of the state highway commission.

The state has been working on the survey for months. The new road will take off at the Sandy river, at Troutdale, and parallel the railroad at the base of the bluff. Highway engineers want to construct a roadbed by

Estimated costs have not been revealed. However, funds are not available at this time but must be borrowed from the federal government. Steps preliminary to asking for PWA moneys have been taken by the commission.

It is anticipated by the state that the federal government will build a fast highway west from Cascade Locks through Bonneville to Warrendale, where the new road proposed by the commission would tie in.

R. H. Babcock, state highway engineer, said in announcing plans for the super road that it was not the state's intention to abandon the old scenic Columbia River highway. Both roads will be maintained .The new one would be given over to commercial travel, the old one to tourists.
