Under the plan reported to have been worked out by the state organization all members from the Bonneville dam area who joined the Eagles last summer and were initiated into the Portland aerie will be transferred to the local aerie.

Merrill's pavilion has been obtained for the initiation on Oct. 18, at which time a large class will be taken into the order.
