## Government Locates Unlimited Water Supply Back Of Locks

Hidden away in the mountains back of Cascade Locks is sufficient water to supply the city of Portland. After sinking almost 70 test holes the government engineers have determined the water level, which is high above the river. The reservoir, if tapped, would yield a sufficient flow of water to water all the lands between town and Herman creek, and provide an inexhaustible supply of water for industrial purposes.

Presence of the water in the mountains is delaying construction of the second section of the Union Pacific railroad tracks, between Eagle creek and the toll bridge.

The government engineers are afraid of this water, for while it is giving no trouble at the present time, it may cause no end of trouble after the lake is formed behind the dam unless tapped and drained into the river.

When the three tunnels now running back into Ruckel slide were started, it was the intention of the war depart-

ment to keep on going until the miners opened a passage-way through which the impounded waters could escape, but at present the engineers are sitting by waiting to see how much water comes out of the mountains after the winter rains set in.

The water level has been found to be higher at the east end of the slide than at the west end, giving rise to the opinion that the water moves downstream, paralleling the river.

Seventeen years ago, when the Union Pacific drove eight tunnels into the mountainside it obtained a flow of 2,000,000 gallons a day. After five years the flow practically ceased, and engineers don't know how the water is escaping.

Tapping the reservoir and making the impounded waters available for use in Cascade Locks and the territory east to Herman creek promises to claim considerable attention during the next few weeks, for its presence would give the district a natural resource enjoyed by no other Pacific northwest city or town and might become a determining factor in attracting industrial plants to the immediate vicinity after power becomes available from the dam.

### Where First Steel Was Made

It is not known definitely when and where the first steel was made. Archeologists state that it was known to the ancients and it is probable that the Assyrians were the first people to use it in the manufacture of tools and weapons. Steel has been used for many centuries in India. The art of hardening and tempering steel was a familiar one to the Greeks in Homer's time, not later than the Ninth century B. C.

### Uses for the Rhinoceros

The ancient Chinese had some strange uses for the rhinoceros, according to a report by an American archeologist. One form of torture was to wrap a political prisoner in the hide of a freshly killed rhinoceros. As the hide dried it contracted and slowly crushed the victim. Another use the ancient Chinese had for rhinoceros skins was for covering funeral cars. Also the armor of the Bronze age warriors was made of it.

### American Blonds Disappearing

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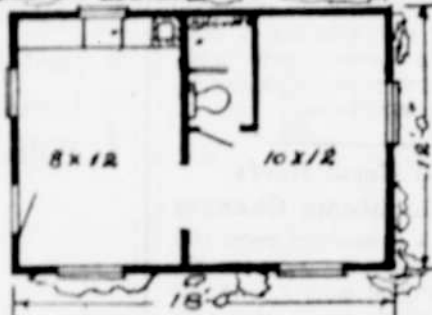
