STATE LAW FORBIDS FIREWORKS ON ROAD

It'll cost you just 75 smackers to shoot firecrackers on the highway or in any forest land this Fourth of July, or any other time during the closed season, May 15 to October 1.

The forest service is making regular and frequent patrols along the Columbia river highway and up forest trails to keep the fire hazard to a minimum. Persons violating the state law providing a \$75 maximum fine for throwing cigarettes, fireworks or other lighted material on highways, roads, railroad rights-of-way or in forests, may get off with a warning from the rangers the first time, are certain to face a hard-boiled justice of the peace the second time.

The only safe place for shooting fireworks is on a river sandbar or island, away from brush and grass which may start a serious fire.

E. C. GUDHART WANTS U. S. TO PAY \$85,000

Mr. and Mrs. E. C. Gudhart owners of Eagle Creek lodge, are asking the government, in Federal Judge McNary's court in Portland, for \$85,000 for property condemned for use in relocating the Union Pacific railroad company's line.

The government claims \$15,000 is all the seized land is worth, that the land remaining to the Gudharts will be so increased in value by the dam that the government actually should not be made to pay for the part seized.

Mr. and Mrs. Gudhart have several times belligerently refused to give any information on their side of the case to representatives of the Chronicle, refused to state what price they paid for the property.

The case is expected to continue in federal court during the coming week.
