With the Bohn Aluminum & Brass Corporation prepared to build a \$10,000,000 plant in the district, Cascade Locks is on the threshold of a great growth.

Wednesday, August 14, you will determine whether the town is to be developed to the advantage of all the people or for the advantage of a few people.

OUR PLATFORM

- 1.—Compel owners of large tracts to pay just and reasonable taxes in order that children of Cascade Locks may have good schools.
- 2.—Provide decent living conditions for families of men employed on Bonneville dam.
- 3.—Deny power company a franchise for period of more than one year. We favor a lower light rate and an adequate system of street lights.
- 4.—We have had no jail in Cascade Locks for 15 years and will build none unless compelled to by force of circumstances.
- 5.—Create a municipal water system.
- 6.—Develop a common sense system of fire protection.
- 7.—Make streets safe for aged and children by enforcing traffic laws.
- 8.—Develop parks and a bathing beach where children play in safety.
- 9.—A fair and impartial business administration.
- 10.—Encourage industries which will utilize low-cost power from Bonneville dam to locate in CASCADE LOCKS.
