LOCKS HIGHWAY CREW RETURNS TO JOB MONDAY

Crews constructing the new Columbia river highway through Cascade Locks returned to work Monday morning after a week's layoff.

Work ceased abruptly early last week, not a single man being kept at work to allay dust or keep the road, almost ready for paving, in repair. Official of F. J. Kernan and company, the contractors, had packed their bags, left without a forwarding address.

Resident State Highway Engineer Frank Walters said their whereabouts were unknown to him, that it was as much a mystery to him as it was to Locks citizens. Sunday night a huge report for boiling the oil to be used in oiling arrived from Lewiston, Idaho. The foreman came back, refused to say where he'd been, how soon paving would start.

It is known that several Locks business men sent a telegram to the state highway department in Salem a week ago protesting the slowness of the job.

WESTERN DAIRY ADDS INNOVATION IN TRUCKS

Western Dairy, with a branch in Hood River, has placed a new truck on its milk run in the Bonneville Dam Area which is something of a new wrinkle. It has compartments for milk, butter and eggs and cheese, and for ice cream. The cold storage compartments can be brought down to a temperature of 25 below zero. This is accomplished by a machine which is hooded up to the truck at night at the plant. The following day the chambers remain well below freezing, thus insuring low temperatures for the dairy products. Beginning September 1 the company will abandon the name of "Hollywood Dairy," now used in the Hood River district, and step out with a new name, which has not yet been announced.

NEW CUT ROAD OPEN

Columbia river highway traffic is now running through the bottom of new Eagle creek railroad and highway cut. Orino, Birke-meir and Saremal, contractors, started cars through it Monday morning as they were ready to widen it to its full width. Cars swing onto the old Eagle creek highway bridge back of Eagle creek.

PORTLAND BANK'S NEW BRANCH



FIRST NATIONAL OPENS BRANCH AT LA GRANDE

The First National Bank of Portland this week opened a branch at La Grande, Oregon, in the quarters of the First National Bank of LaGrande. The entire assets of the La Grande bank were acquired in the transaction. A. K. Parker, cashier of the former bank, will be manager of the new branch.

Deposits of the La Grande bank, when the transfer was made totaled \$1,350,000. It will now serve a community which is the trading center for a large area producing livestock, grain and

lumber.

The First National Bank of Portland opened a branch in Stayton in May. Other branches operated by the Portland institution include Albany, Astoria, Condon, Gresham, Hillsboro, Pendleton, Heppner, The Dalles, Salem, Woodburn and Stayton in addition to eight Portland branches. Resources of The First National at last statement call, June 29, were \$62,679,568.82.
