Born in Sweden, August Peterson came to America in the early '80's as a young man. Soon he was working as a stone mason on the locks. Cascade Locks was only a clearing at the edge of the woods and game was plentiful. In 1885 he returned to his old home, where he met the girl that he was to marry. Mrs. Peterson came to America in 1890. She spent some time in Kansas, then moved on to San Francisco. The couple were married in 1894 and set up house-keeping in a small house, near where their present home now stands.
