With the completion of the south side of the locks last Sunday another milestone was passed in the completion of the dam project. The north wall is taking more time than the south wall as entrance to the fish locks are on that side. The job will be completed by the end of the month if everything goes as planned. The second pour in the fish locks will be made the latter part of this week.

In the power house the forms are ready for the pour in unit one of the draft tubes. Seventy percent of the pour has been completed in this unit. This brings the pour up to the steel liners, which are being put in place this week. In unit two the forms will be in place by the end of the week and the pour will probably start then. Steel arrived for the liners in this unit Monday.

In the station service unit the forms will probably be all in place by the end of the week.
