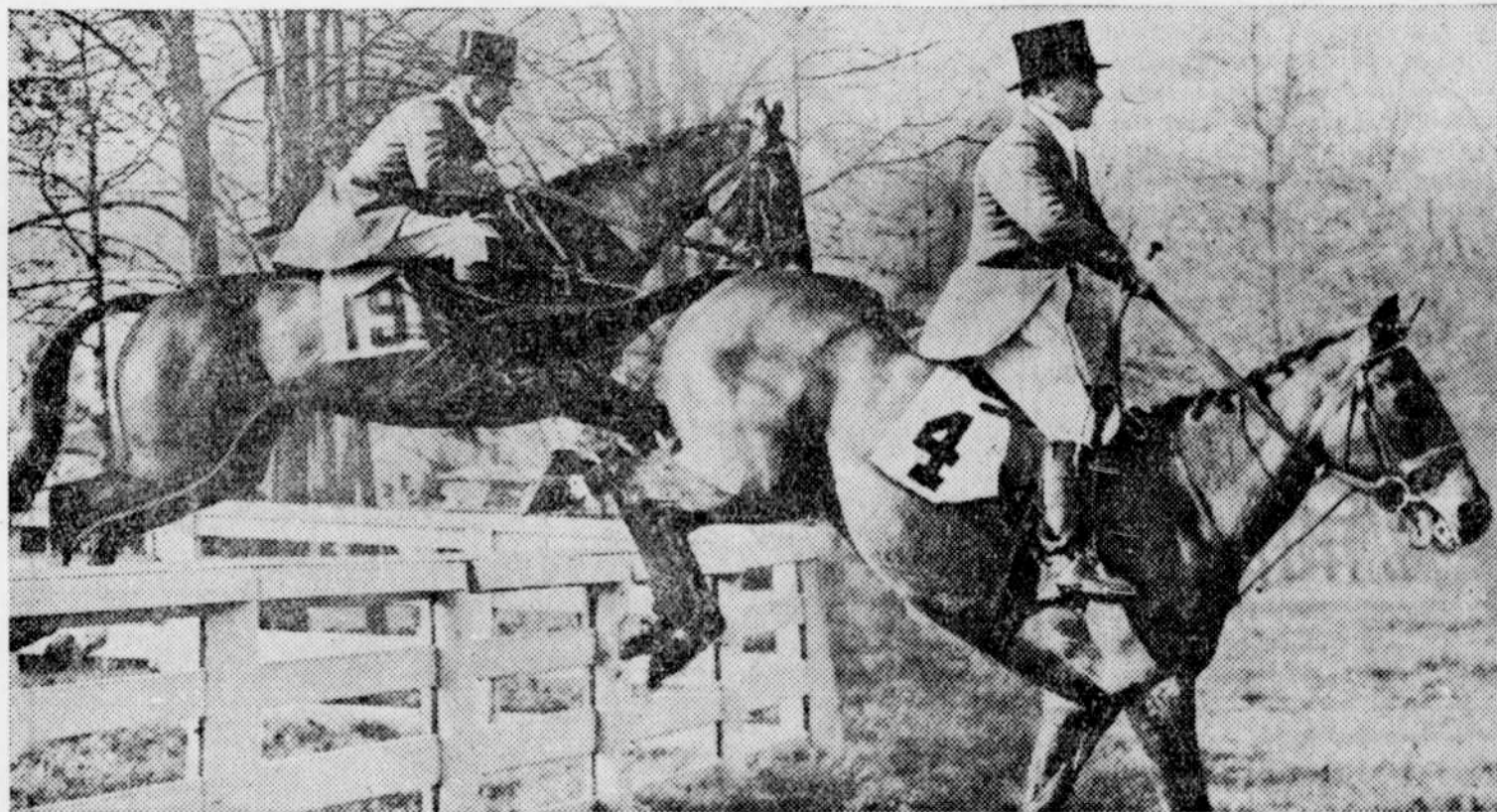

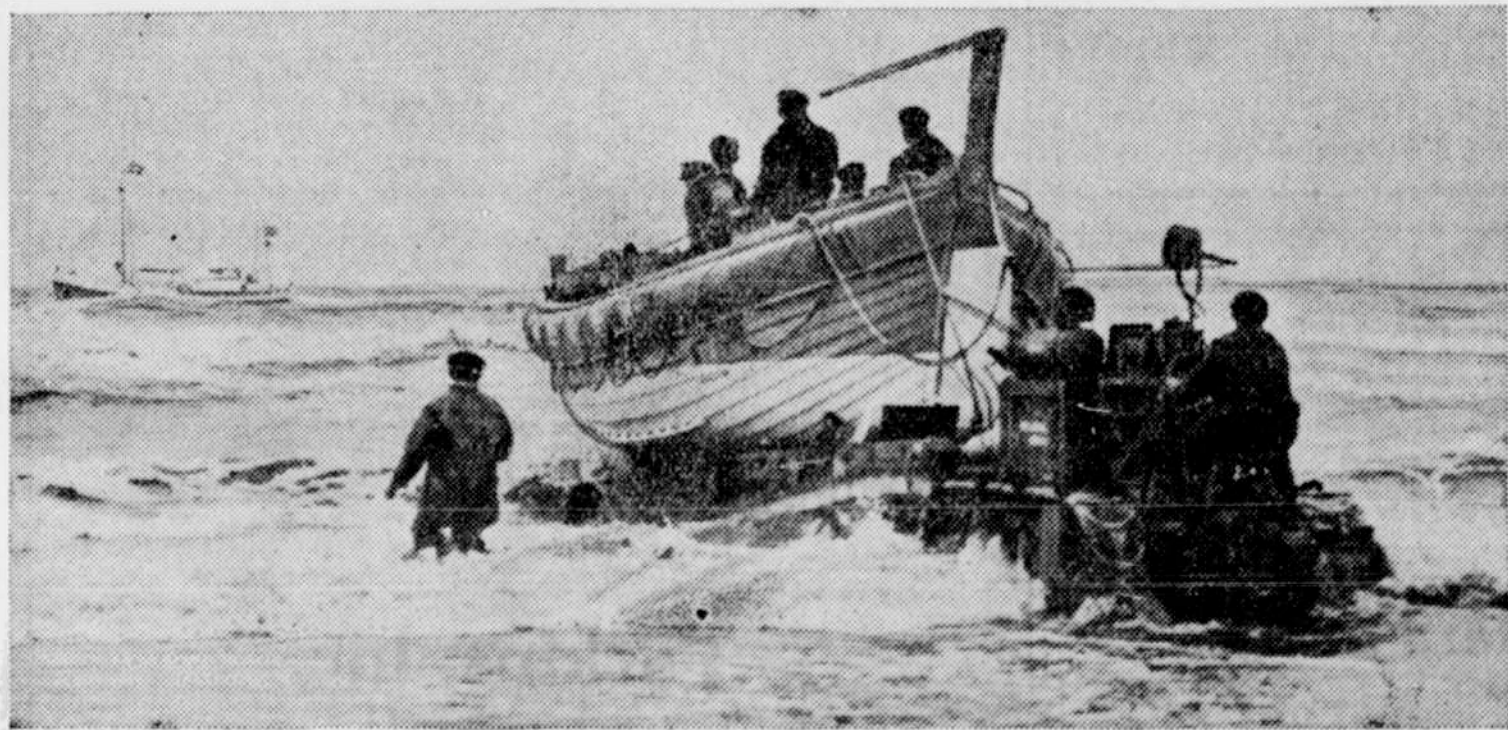

Denny Shute Is New Pro Golf Champion

Takes Cup From Jimmy Thomson in Closed Match

Denny Shute, professional of the West Newton, Mass., Braeburn club, with the cup he won in the national professional golfers' tournament. Denny defeated Jimmy Thomson 3 and 2 in the final 36-hole match of the P. G. A. championship tournament to win this cup, and the national pro golfing title.

Shute, who is one of the youngest champions ever to win the crown, competed with leading professionals from every part of the United States in the elimination matches, reaching the semi-finals with flying colors and defeating Thomson in a close fought battle in the finals.
