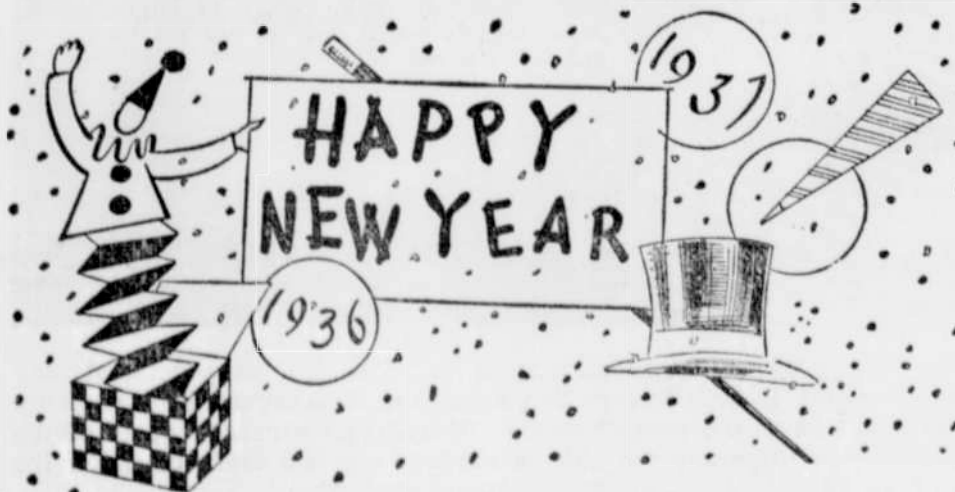

Vic Howell, Skiing, Strikes Stump, Dies

Vic Howell, son of Mr. and Mrs. Frank Howell and Hood River high school graduate of last June, was killed instantly at 1:15 P. M. Tuesday when skiing on an old ski hill about a mile south of Homestead.

Howell, who was skiing with Howard Walters as his sole companion, was thrown forward when the tip of his ski pierced the light snow and struck the top of a small stump. His chest struck a second stump as he came down.

He was extremely well known and well liked in Hood River, having played football and been student body president at the high school. He was the youngest member of the Crag Rats, having been just recently elected.

This Little Pig

Yes, he's on his way to market, but when you are ready to start him and his little brothers on the way, whether by truck or rail, any effort to make him weigh more by over-feeding or watering is not a profitable practice, according to tests made by the Ohio Experiment Station. Feeding in the cars or trucks, or immediately before shipment tends to suffocate hogs and increases death rate en route 25 to 30 per cent, according to their reports.

Many tests made over periods of time by various state agricultural colleges prove conclusively that the best practice in shipping any live stock is to feed and water on day before shipment exactly as usual. The practice of withholding water so cattle, sheep or hogs will drink large quantities after being unloaded at the market is not profitable, they report, as this is easily detected by buyers and they make due allowance in bidding for the animals. Over-feeding before or during shipment also tends to produce digestive disorders that lower the prices offered by market buyers.

Shippers are also advised to cull out any sick animals, or any that have been recently dehorned, castrated, branded, vaccinated or foundered, as these will lower the grade of the rest of the animals.
