### AIR-CONDITIONED TOURIST CARS INSTALLED

Portland, May 25—A new line of air-conditioned tourist sleeping cars, beginning early in June, will provide Oregon and Washington with through service to Denver and Kansas City, according to J. C. Cummings, general passenger agent of the Union Pacific.

This service, meeting popular preference for economy coupled with comfort, Cumming said, will begin June 4, leaving Seattle at 4:20 P. M., Tacoma at 5:30 P. M., and Portland at 9:35 P. M., on the Portland Rose, arriving at Denver at 10:30 A. M. and at Kansas City at 7:30 A. M. Westbound, it begins June 1 with the departure of the Pacific Limited, train

No. 21, from Kansas City.

This is in addition to similar through service already provided by the Portland Rose to Chicago.

It is also announced that, effective June 5, the Pacific Limited, leaving Portland at 8 A. M., will carry a new line of air-conditioned Pullman tourist sleepers, inaugurating economy travel between Portland and Chicago without change of cars, arriving at Omaha at 8:30 A. M. and Chicago at 8:45 P. M., three days and two nights from Portland. This service starts westbound with the departure of the Challenger from Chicago June 1.
