A. E. Jakku Elected to County Board

Armas E. Jakku, Odell, was elected a member of the county school board Monday, when he defeated George E. Morell by a vote of 301 to 119, according to information received here. Jakku succeeds George Galligan who recently moved to California.

The result of polls in the ten sub-districts was as follows: Cascade Locks, Jakku 28, Morell 27; Frank-ton, Jakku 2, Morell 4; Barrett, Jakku 9, Morell 6; Odell, Jakku 107, Morell 4; Parkdale, Jakku 89, Morell 28; Pine Grove, Jakku 4, Morell 31; Mount Hood, Jakku 4, Morell 8; Oak Grove, Jakku 30, Morell 3; Central Vale, Jakku 28, Morell 0; Dee, Jakku 0, Morell 8.

John Duckwall was re-elected as director of Hood River school district No. 3 on Monday. Duckwall, the only man running, drew the entire 23 votes cast.

Army Will Not Raise Bridges

Plans for the financing of the alterations in the Hood River-White Salmon bridge and the Bridge of the Gods hits a new obstacle with a report from Washington, D. C., that the board of Army Engineers had turned down Senator Charles McNary's proposal that the government bear these costs. The alterations are due to the construction of the Bonneville dam which will raise the pool level of the Columbia river.

"The alterations of the bridges—the Hood River bridge and the Bridge of the Gods—at federal expense cannot be recommended by the war department because of the legal precedence involved," the report stated.

Engineers estimate the cost of the work at \$800,000.

Senator McNary, in introducing the enabling legislation, said he felt the government should pay for the alteration inasmuch as construction of the federal project made the change necessary.

The bridge approaches of the Hood River bridge and the installation of a draw are the main changes in the Hood River bridge, while the engineers have stated that the Bridge of the Gods must be raised 54 feet and new approaches built. This raising of the Bridge of the Gods would place the present deck at an elevation equal to that of the top of the towers of the bridge at the present time.
