Seal Sale Will Open Tomorrow

With the launching of the Christmas Seal sale Thanksgiving Day, every family in Hood River County will be urged to put aside a substantial sum in their December budget to help support the all year round fight against tuberculosis.



"We talk a great deal about automobile accidents and carry on valiantly our 'safe driving' campaigns, as well we should," stated Mrs. Jesse Jones, county seal sale chairman. "Yet these accidents, caused by carelessness, do not take half as many lives as this preventable disease, tuberculosis, which is, tragically, the highest cause of death for our young men and women between 15 and 45 years of age. Christmas Seal funds help fight tuberculosis in your town, your county, state and nation. Here is your chance to serve your community."

A change in a National Tuberculosis Association ruling gives Hood River County a chance to retain for local use 75 per cent of the gross sum received in the seal sale this year if over 8 stamps per capita are sold. Last year 8.9 stamps per capita in this county won the highest place in the state. So the local health association has for its slogan for the next three weeks, "Over the top with over 8 per capita."

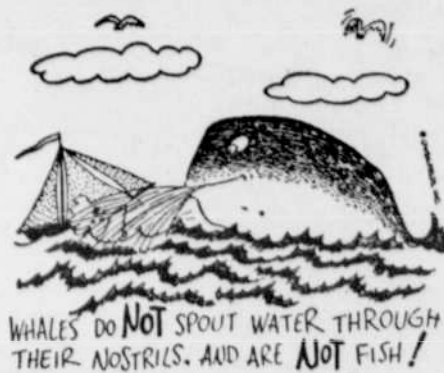

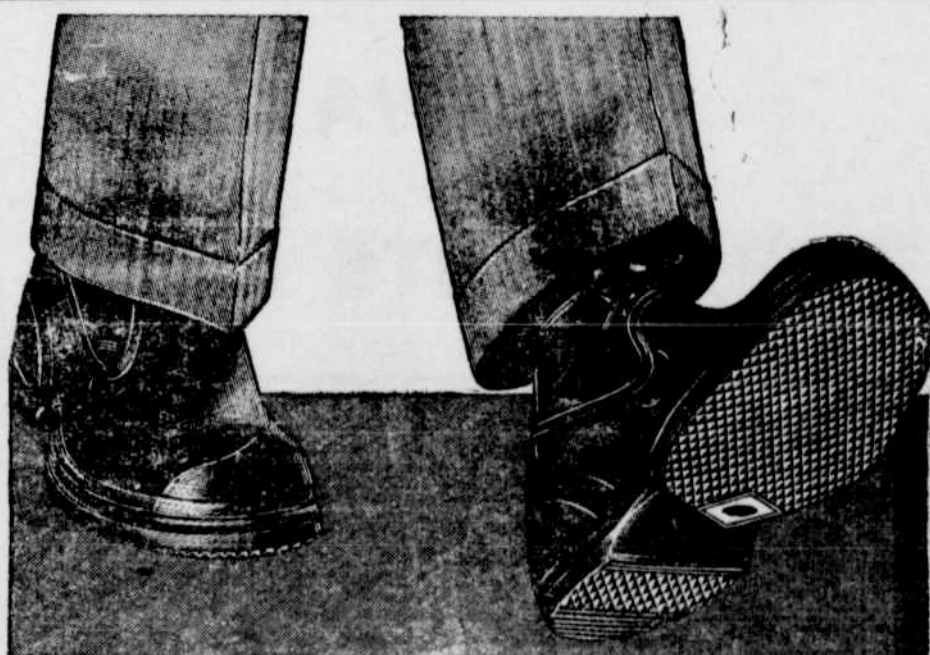
