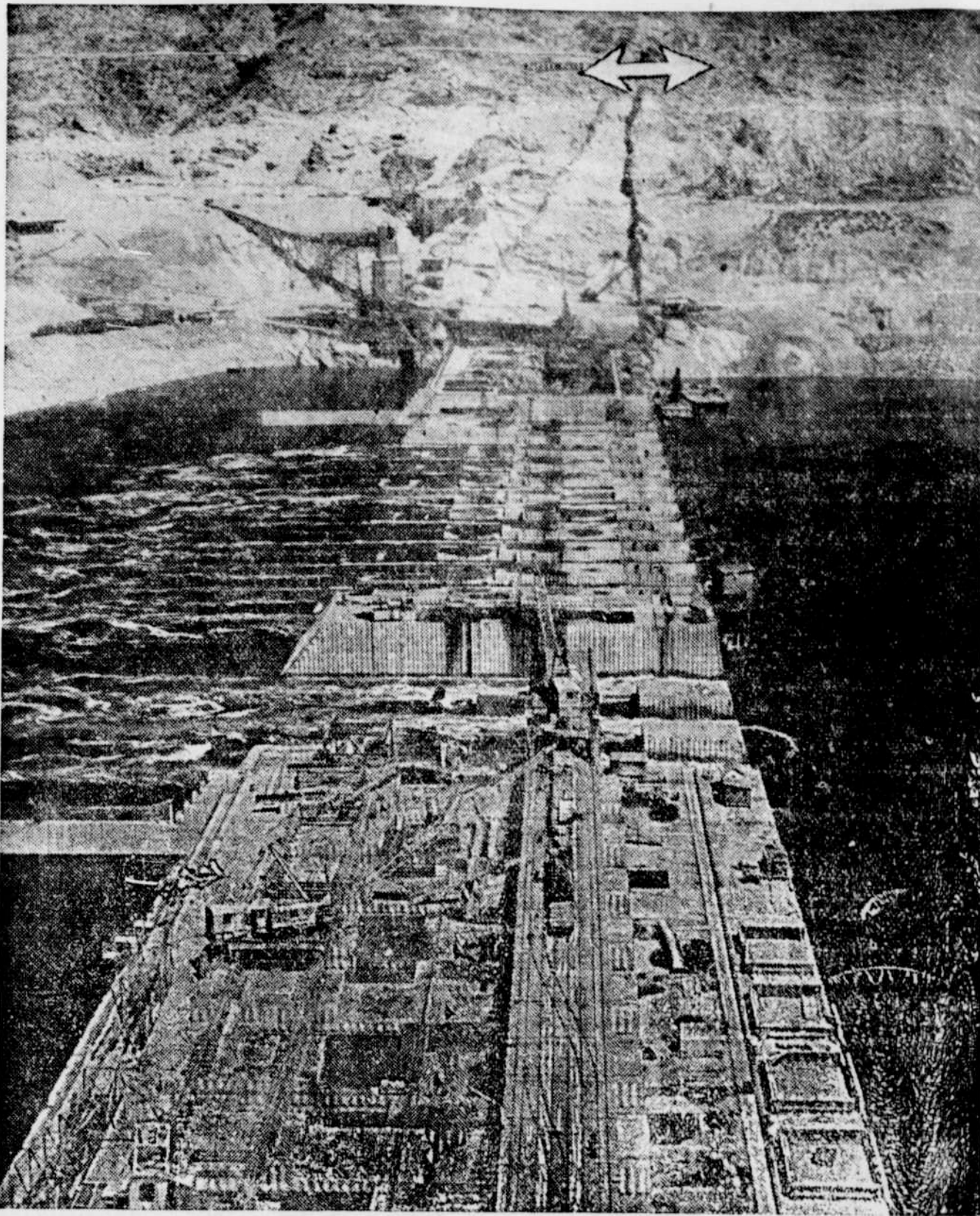


Recent View of the Grand Coulee Dam
