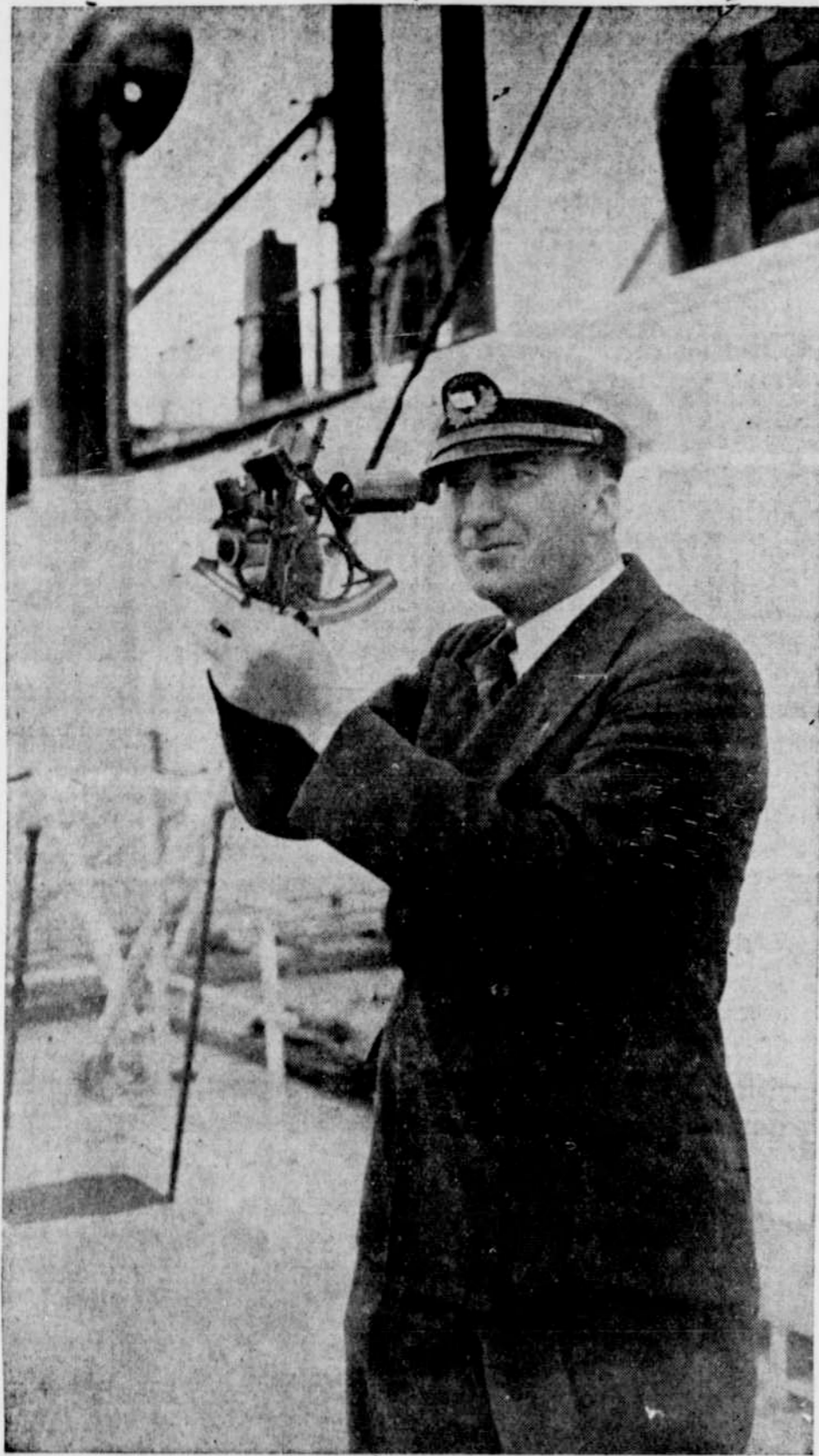


Peering into the Future

RECIPE

Hot Potato Salad—

Left-over potatoes can be saved for hot German potato salad. If desired, bits of left-over ham or hard-cooked egg can also be added for additional flavor in the dish. For 6 persons, 6 potatoes are needed. Pan broil four slices of bacon. Chop one onion and saute in the hot bacon fat. Heat ¼ cup of water, ½ cup of vinegar, 1 teaspoon sugar, ½ teaspoon salt, ¼ teaspoon pepper. Add to the onion mixture. Add the minced bacon and combine with the potatoes. Heat and serve hot.

The temperature of the rinse water can make all the difference in the world between clothes that are bright and clean and those which have a dirty, grayish cast. A cold rinse defeats its purpose. It hardens the soap in the meshes of the fabric and makes its removal difficult. The hot rinse is desirable with white cottons and linens. With colored clothes, a tepid water is much safer.

When the tablecloth wears thin in the center, cut the outside into 12 or 16 squares and hemstitch them. These make nice napkins that will wear for some time.
