

Radio Dealers Point To Big Show

Determined to make the 1939 Radio Show, outstanding, Hood River radio dealers are hard at work on the arrangements for the big free show which they will present here in cooperation with Pacific Power & Light Company, the afternoon and evening of October 31, at the Columbia Gorge Hotel.

The coming event promises to be outstanding both in exhibits and in entertainment. There will be representative displays of new 1939 models of all radio sets sold locally. There will be novelty exhibits illustrating the growth and development of radio. Ellis Van Atta, radio interference engineer for Pacific Power & Light Company, will be on hand with a demonstration of simple things to do to avoid radio interference and to get improved reception in your home.

There has never been any free entertainment offered here to equal that arranged for the show, which brings to town the Trail Blazers, famous group of radio musicians and novelty entertainers featured by KGW and NBC.

Master of ceremonies and leading vocalist will be Clarence Tolman who has brought to radio the artistry and showmanship learned during a long career on the concert stage, in Broadway musical comedy and in pictures. One of the outstanding radio personalities of the west, he has been featured over NBC and is currently heard as master of ceremonies of "Everybody Sing" over KEX. He is "Toley" of "Toley and Glenn," and frequently stars in "Covered Wagon Days." In addition to possessing a fine tenor voice and stellar acting ability, Tolman is an expert cowhand. In fact he began his musical career while punching cattle in Idaho.

Featured pianist and accordion player with the Trail Blazers is "Snootie" Hamilton, who began his work as a professional musician as pianist and arranger for Rubinoff's

first orchestra years ago in Minneapolis. Hamilton is also a pipe organist of outstanding ability. Other members of the group are "Johnny" Johnson, violinist and fiddle player; "Jake" Schmidt, guitar, banjo, and novelty instrument player; and "Poke Pickens" Nash, whose favorite instruments are the electric steel and Spanish guitar, mandolin, mandola and banjo.

Troupers all, their entertainment includes instrumental solos, duos, trios, and in combination with vocalists and novelty entertainment. The group will pattern their full program along the lines of a radio broadcast, and definite word and music cues will be used just as they would on their many radio programs to show the audience, perhaps some of them for the first time, just how a radio show is produced. Sound effects will be utilized and the incidental novelty instruments will be highly entertaining to the spectators. These radiocasts will be given at 4 p. m., 8 p. m., and 9 p. m.

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Unemployment Claims For County \$2450

A 29 per cent reduction in distribution of unemployment compensation was noted by the Oregon Commission for September, officials declaring the drop expected because of continued favorable employment conditions and further final exhaustion of current benefit rights.

Final 1938 checks were mailed to 1969 claimants, bringing the total of those who have been paid in full to 26,687.

Hood River, claim center for Hood River County, accounted for \$2450, or 8 per cent of the state total.

Total disbursements through the state's 22 employment offices were \$292,711, distributed over 28,068 checks. This brought the total benefit payments since January to \$5,021,344.

GROWS FREAK CUCUMBER

A cucumber which entirely fills a glass gallon jug was being displayed by Harry DeWitt at his office of the Hood River Stage depot. The cucumber, when it was in its infancy and about the size of a pickle, was placed in the neck of the jug. It grew downward to the bottom of the jar, grew into a curve and reversed its direction of elongated growth back toward the top.

It is explained that the extreme length and size of the cucumber is due to the additional heat generated in the bottle, whose curvature intensified the sun's rays. The cucumber is about 19 inches in length and down in below the neck of the jug is about two and one-half inches in diameter.
