GARDENERS want flowers for house bouquets, for beautification of the yard, or both. To be certain of an abundance of flowers for cutting throughout the only three or four of the following flowers:

Annuals-snapdragon, aster, calendula, calliopsis, candytuft, carnation, bachelor button, cosmos, dahlia, larkspur, annual lupin, and zinnia.

Perennials-columbine, coreopsis, gaillardia grandiflora, perennial lupin, pyrethrum (painted daisy) shasta daisy and delphinium.

For earliest bloom, the following are recommended by Gilbert Bentley, flower expert: Calliopsis and candytuft among the annuals, and coreopsis, delphinium and pyrethrum among the perennials.

A few notes taken at random stress the following wool news. The importance of flannels for the spring suits and coats is not to be overlooked.


Leading couturiers are doing delightful things with the new thin muslin wools. There are many wool coats and redingote fashions in the spring collections.
