Mr. and Mrs. Kruger and son of Portland are renting the Helmer Sundsten home. Mr. Kruger is employed at Bonneville.

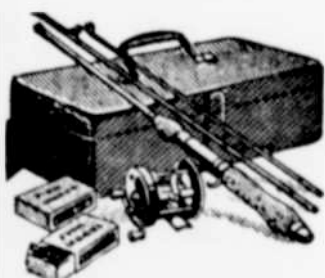
