




SEEMS TO WORK

Reports have been favorable regarding the stamp method of distributing surplus food to needy families. It has been tried in three cities, Rochester, N. Y., Dayton, Ohio, and Seattle, Wash., where the experiment proved successful. It is to be tried in other towns soon. We are glad that it has increased consumption for those undernourished and that it has helped cut down on the farm surplus. Orange stamps, costing \$1, may be bought by direct relief or relief wage. With each orange stamp goes a blue one worth 50 cents in the purchasing of only surplus food produce. The stamps are good at any co-operating grocery store and the government redeems these stamps at their face value. We will watch the experiment in the hundred other cities to be added. The idea of relieving the surplus crops is feasible to every one in Hood River.
