After this the whole is dipped into a coarse strainer cloth, spread in the cheese basket and placed over a tub to drain. It is then chopped in a chopping bowl, rubbed into small pieces and salted ready for the cheese hoops, when it is gently pressed until the whey is all expelled. The curd is then soaked in salt and water in a tub or jar, and the amount required is stated on its strength and must be learned by experience. A tablespoonful to a gallon of milk is about the usual quantity. When on the shelf to dry the cheese must be rubbed daily with grease made from heated butter until it is cured. While a quite small fruit or cider press might be used, it would not be well
