OUR MECHANICAL FACILITIES.

A full and complete job office is run in connection and work of all kinds, from a large 36x45 poster to the smallest, neatest visiting card, can be turned out quickly.

Our facilities for quick and large work are of the best. Our plant consists of one of Hoe's steam cylinder presses, with a capacity of 3000 papers per hour.

The power is furnished by a three-horse power engine, which runs both the cylinder and job presses. Steam is generated in a six-horse power boiler which will before the coming winter furnish steam for a complete steam outfit. Electric lights will be put in, and then we will claim the largest, neatest and best newspaper plant in the state outside of Portland.

All our friends and enemies, old and young, are requested to call at this office and inspect the newspaper plant.

OUR HISTORY.

THE TELEPHONE-REGISTER entered upon the first year of its existence on the first of February, 1889. It is the consolidation of the TELEPHONE and REGISTER, the former a democratic newspaper published at McMinnville, and the latter a democratic newspaper published at Lafayette. The proprietors thinking that a consolidated paper would be for the best interests of the county, a partnership was formed. When THE TELEPHONE-REGISTER was first issued its press rooms contained two antiquated hand presses. They have been displaced with a magnificent press equipment with a capacity of 3000 papers per hour.

THE TELEPHONE-REGISTER under its present management has become the leading paper of Yamhill county, being first in circulation, first in advertising, first in mechanical facilities, first in revenues, first in expenditures, first in everything by which a newspaper's success is usually measured.
