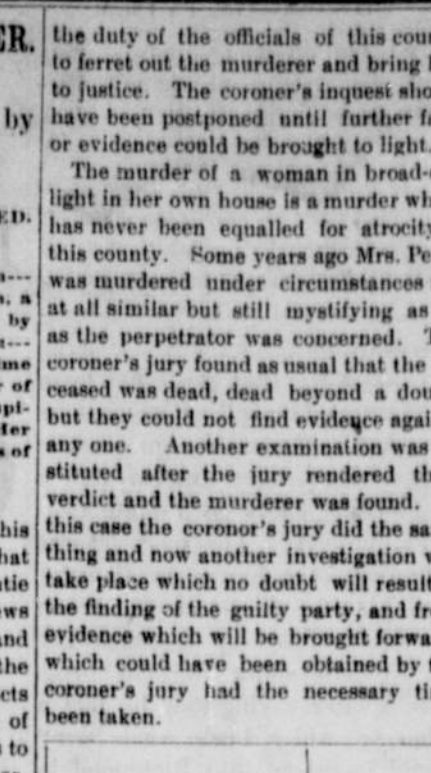
LOCAL AND GENERAL.
