SAMUEL J. RANDALL.

Hon. Samuel J. Randall died at 5 o'clock Sunday morning. Samuel Jackson Randall was born in Philadelphia, October 10, 1828.

Mr. Randall was a member of the "First City Troop" of Philadelphia, which, immediately after the fall of Fort Sumpter, tendered its services to the government...

At the convening of the thirty-eighth congress Mr. Randall took his seat in the house of representatives, and has been re-elected to every succeeding congress.

When the democrats came into power at the opening of the forty-fourth congress in December, 1875, Mr. Randall was made chairman of the committee on appropriations.

He devoted himself to the work of retrenchment and succeeded in cutting down the appropriations many millions.

On December 4, 1876, Mr. Randall was elected to fill a vacancy in the office of speaker, occasioned by the death of Michael C. Kerr, and was re-elected, serving in that capacity until March 3, 1881.

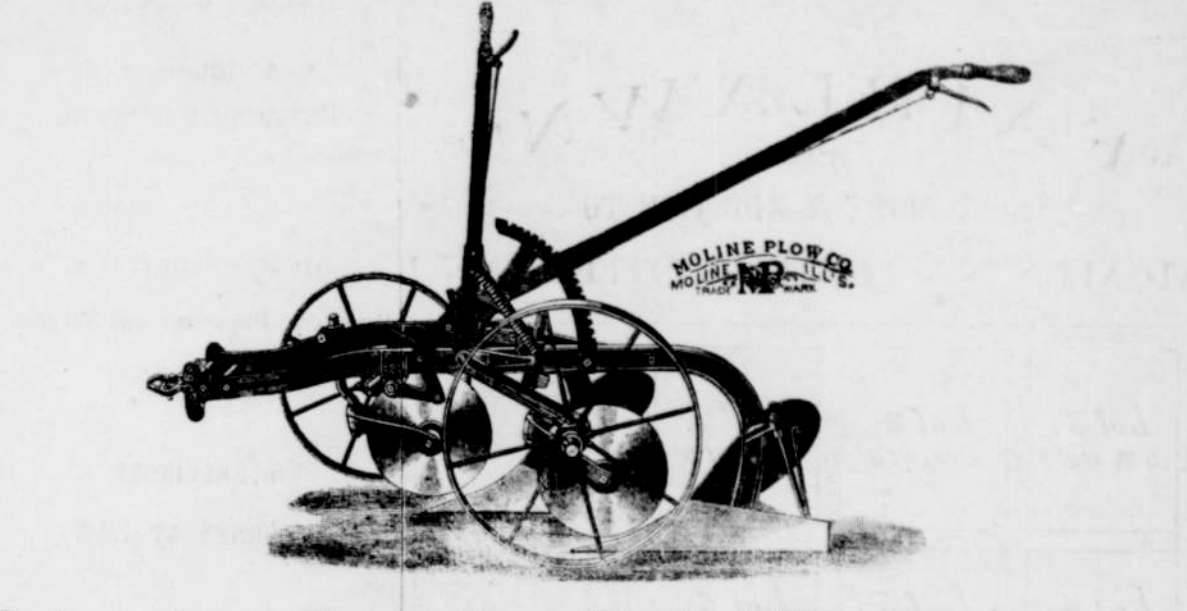
