A most horrible suicide is reported from near Seattle, in which an unknown man threw himself in front of a coal train, but the engineer succeeded in stopping the train before it reached him. Seeing he had failed, the man jumped to his feet and escaped into the bushes, but later when the 2 o'clock passenger came along at the rate of 25 miles an hour, the same man sprang from the bushes in front of the engine in an instant he was caught, his legs and arms crushed and ground, his head horribly mashed and mutilated and his body cut in two pieces. The train was stopped and the remains of the man and his identity is unknown.

The Sheridan Courier remarks that a motor line connecting Sheridan and McMinville is a good scheme and so it would, and why not have it. We learn that Dayton merchants are now opposed to a motor line between Dayton and this city because Dayton people would come to McMinville to trade. This is an old mossback idea and it should be thrown away. The merchants of Dayton should oppose the building of a railroad to their fair little city because people would then go to Portland to trade. Where one dollar is taken away from a town through any enterprise of merit, hundreds are brought in. A motor line like a railroad will build up a town and especially a motor from Sheridan to Dayton by way of McMinville and Lafayette would do more for Dayton than her merchants ever will.

One look at the suburbs of this city and any one can see that the city is growing. New houses can be seen on every hand, some in progress of construction, some already built and families living in them. Still with all this building activity, houses to rent and desirable business places are scarce. Good rents can be obtained and why our capitalists do not help the city out in the way of new and commodious buildings is a mystery.
