Continued from Second Page. The side doors will let you look at and handle any tray while curing, while the end doors will not. It is advisable to grade prunes and get those nearly of a size together on trays, then the smaller sizes can be taken out as fast as cured. Dr. Sharples has slides that fill up the space where there is no tray and so saves the heat.
