

Filb rt Crop.

In some districts of Italy the filbert crop is said to rival in commercial importance the produce of the vine. These delicious nuts are grown on bushes planted in groups that are from cife, and at Orden with Rio Grande fifteen feet to twenty-five feet apart, so as to insure the access of plenty of light and air. They thrive best in a deep clayey soil, and the planting in Italy takes place in November and December of slips from the mother plant. The bushes fruit in the third year. They are pruned annually. 


