SEC. 1. That on the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November, adoption of the joint resolution A. D. 1887, the legal voters of Yam fixing the time in November for hill county, state of Oregon, shall the county seat of said Yambill county. The poll books for said election shall be ruled and prepared so as holding two special elections in to provide a sufficient number of columus for recording and counting all the votes cast for relocating the county seat of said Yambill county.

SEC. 2. Each voter voting upon the question of relocating the said county seat shall have written or to the county. printed upon his ballot the name of the place for which he votes for counmajority of all the legal votes cast for county seat of said Yambill county,
