The Attorney General has made response to an inquiry of the Interior, asking whether a body of about 1,000 Indians who are natives of and residents within the limits of British Columbia, who have attained an advanced state of civilization, are self-supporting, and are organized into a community, can go into Alaska as emigrants and then secure such rights as are accorded to the residents of that territory who are not residents. Also whether it would be competent for the president to set aside as a reservation for such colony a reasonable portion of unoccupied land. The Attorney General states that the immigration of peaceful individual Indians who have dissolved tribal relations is not prohibited by statute, and is not inconsistent with the policy of our government. But such privileges is not accorded to a tribe born and residing outside of this country.
