"The Search," a moving story of a little Czechoslovakian boy's search for his mother following the war, is being sponsored by the Mill City Parent-Teacher Assn. Thursday, April 28, at the local theater.
School Superintendent Vernon Todd said he considered this film so excellent that high school and upper grade pupils will be allowed to attend the special matinee at 2 p.m. that day.

Acclaimed everywhere as an outstanding picture, its juvenile star, Erik Jandi, added more laurels to the film by winning the Academy Award for the best child performance of the year. With exception to Aline MacMahon and two American girls, the entire cast is European, and the story actually filmed in postwar Berlin. German, French, Bohemian and Hebrew are spoken and translated.

Children under 14 will be admitted for 25 cents; adults 60 cents. Proceeds will be used to finish payment on new drapes for the high school auditorium and for the respirator fund.
