LOSES EYE

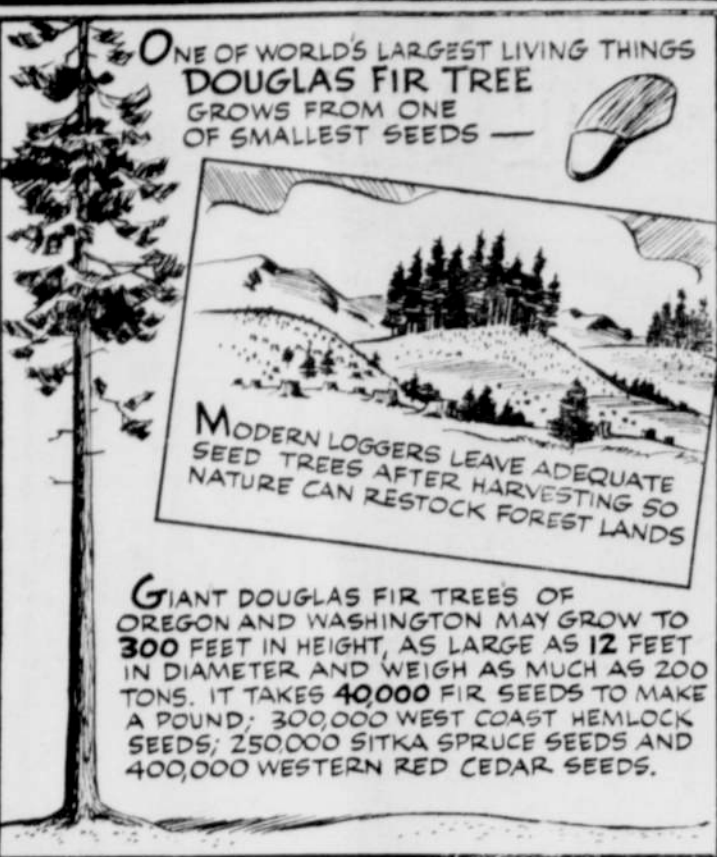

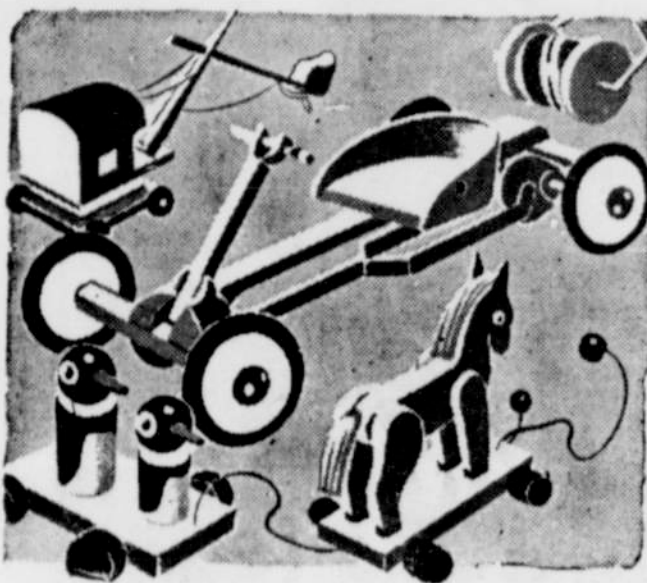
