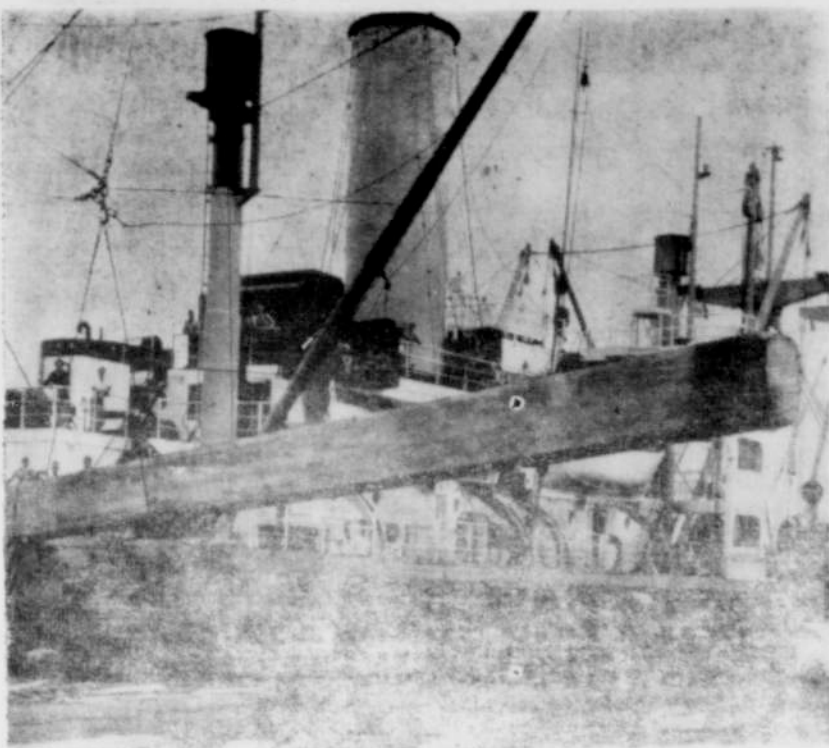


Canyon Ship Timbers Reach Boston



THE FIRST of four 70 foot fir timbers cut in the Marion forks area above Idanha is shown being unloaded from steamer, Kenyon Victory at Castle Island, Boston, last week. They are to be used in construction of new bowsprit for the famous frigate, Constitution in Boston Naval Yard. Weighing five tons and measuring nearly 100 feet on each side, the timbers will be banded together.
